



Brandon "Mike" Remley

November 30, 1979 - January 5, 2022

Brandon M. "Mike" Remley, 42, passed away Wednesday, January 5, 2022, peacefully in his sleep at home. Though in poor health, and disabled, the last 10 years of his life, his death was unexpected.

Mike was born to William "Bill" and Barbara Ward Remley, of Hagerstown, on November 30, 1979 in Richmond. He was a 1998 graduate of Hagerstown High School, and earned an Associate's Degree, in 1999, from Lincoln Tech, Indianapolis.

He had been employed at Peerless Faucets, Indianapolis; Woodruff Corporation, Richmond; and Grede Foundaries, New Castle. Mike was a member of Calvary Baptist Church, Connersville and the Lucky Seven Car Club of New Castle.

In addition to his loving parents, Mike is survived by his brother Rob (Autumn) Remley of Economy; Aunts Von Braden, of Greencastle; Millie Largen of Connersville; and Uncle Jim Ward of Martineze, GA. He is also survived by cousin Cody Crist of Connersville and beloved pets Toby, Hermie and Pebbles.
