



Carmen M. Linderman

May 20, 1942 - November 30, 2025

Carmen Marie Linderman passed away on November 30, 2025, at Reid Hospital in Richmond, Indiana. She was 83 years old.

Carmen was born on May 20, 1942, to Mary Frances Lloyd Horsley (nee Judd) and Lester Lloyd. Her father passed away in 1947, when Carmen was 5. She graduated from Newport High School in Newport, Kentucky, in 1962 and studied nursing at Jewish Hospital in Cincinnati, Ohio. She graduated from nursing school in August 1965 and was a registered nurse for many years.

On October 15, 1965, she married John Linderman, who was the love of her life. They lived for many years at the Linderman family farm in Greens Fork, where John was raised. They raised their two sons, Mike and Mark, on the farm and later in life enjoyed spending time with their grandchildren there.

Carmen was a devoted wife and mother, a “band mom” for the Hagerstown High School Marching band for both of her sons, and a school nurse at Centerville-Abington School Corporation from 1993 until her retirement in 2007. She enjoyed spending time with her family, shopping and antiquing, vegetable gardening, and cooking. After retirement, she volunteered as a nurse for the Wayne County Health Department's “Flu Crew” and was an active member of Wayne County, Indiana, Extension Homemakers.

Surviving are her sons Mike (Kate) Linderman of Evansville, Indiana, and Mark (Jennifer) Linderman of New Castle, Indiana; a sister, Mary Lynn Richards of Maysville, Kentucky; a brother, Rusty Horsely of Vanceburg, Kentucky; and four grandchildren: Mary Rachel and Josephine Linderman of Evansville, Jack (Sydney) Linderman of Indianapolis, and Nolan Linderman of New Castle.

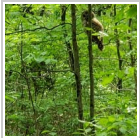
