



Charles D. Paddock

March 9, 1922 - October 17, 2016

Charles D. Paddock, 94, a long time Hagerstown resident, died at his home, near Greenfield, on Monday, October 17, 2016.

He was born near Millville on March 9, 1922 to Charles M. and Lydia O. (Stonecipher) Paddock and lived most of his life in the Hagerstown area. He had resided in the Greenfield area for the past 10 years.

He was a 1940 graduate of Hagerstown High School. Charles served with the US Army during WW II and was stationed in London and Weisbaden, Germany. During that time he was active with United Nation Forces Witness Team.

An accountant, he retired from Perfect Circle / Dana Corp. after 35 years of service. Following his retirement, he was employed by the Hagerstown Exponent, Perfect Circle Credit Union and Lydia's Restaurant. He was an income tax preparer for 27 years.

He was a 55 year member of Hagerstown Optimist Club and a member of Henry County Historical Society.

Survivors include 2 children, Carol (Stephen Peck) Paddock of Indianapolis and Stephen C. Paddock of Colombia, SC; 2 grandsons, David Peck and

Daniel Peck, both of Indianapolis and a sister, Mary Louise Paddock Slaughterbeck, of West Milgrove, OH.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Velma (Overman) Paddock; a daughter, Janet Sue Paddock and 4 sisters, Doris Paddock Riley, Vera Paddock Wilson Taylor, Marian Paddock Colvin and Blanche Paddock Petty.

Services will be at 11:00 AM on Monday, October 24, at Nettle Creek Church of the Brethren. Pastor Brian Mackie will officiate. Burial will be in Brick Cemetery. Visitation will be 4 to 6 PM on Sunday at Culberson Funeral Home, Hagerstown, and at the church after 10:30 AM on Monday.

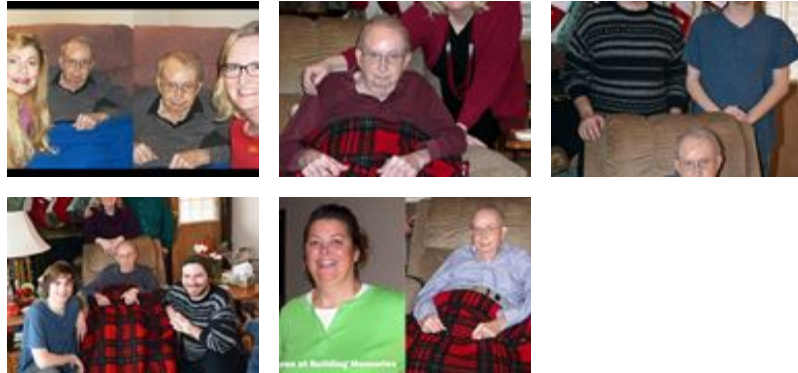
I also just learned from his obituary that Blanche has also passed. I would love to keep in touch with Moms family. I will leave my email and I am on facebook as well if you are interested.
