Charles R. "Red" Ramey, 89, passed away at his home on Saturday, December 28, 2024.

He was born October 8, 1935 to Isaac and Blanche (Turner) Ramey. He grew up in Hagerstown and was a 1954 graduate of Hagerstown High School. He lived most of his life in Wayne County.

He worked for 6 months at a Kroger store in Indianapolis. He worked as a toolmaker for Perfect Circle/Dana Corp. for 34 years. Following that, he was employed by Precision Wire Assemblies for 14 years.
