



D. Richard "Dick" Culberson

April 25, 1930 - March 16, 2016

David Richard "Dick" Culberson, 85, of Hagerstown, died Wednesday, March 16, 2016, at Cornerstone Hospice, Tavares, FL.

He was born in Delaware County on April 25, 1930, the son of David R. and Lois (Neff) Culberson. He lived in North Webster before moving to Hagerstown in 1970.

Dick owned and operated Culberson Funeral Home from 1970 until his retirement, several years ago. He was a member of Hagerstown Lodge #49, F&AM and past master of Masonic Lodges in North Webster and Leesburg, IN. He was a former member of North Webster and Hagerstown Volunteer Fire Departments and was past president of Hagerstown Lions Club.

Survivors include 2 children, Rick Culberson of Hagerstown and Sally Culberson of Leesburg, FL; his companion, Helen Kamhout of Leesburg, FL; 4 grandchildren, Jim Culberson (Kiely) of Middletown, Michele Webb (Brandon) of Richmond, Sara Macosko (Ben) of Erie, PA and Meghan Bunting of Seattle, WA; great-grandchildren, Zach, Carley, Blake and Ian.

His wife of 62 years, Bernie Culberson, preceded him in death in 2012.

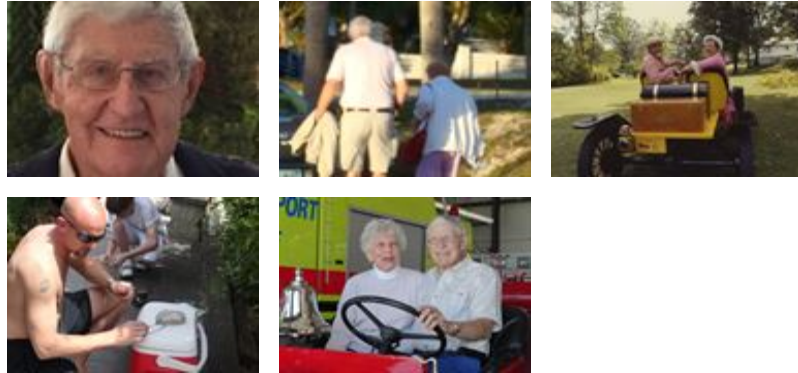
