David William Reneau, 87, a longtime Hagerstown resident, died Wednesday, November 6, 2019, at Brookdale Health Care, where he had resided for the past several weeks.

Dave was born in Mays, IN on June 20, 1932 to Clarence and Ethel (McCullum) Reneau and live most of his life in Wayne County.

Dave was a 1951 graduate of Hagerstown High School. After graduation, he served 4 years in the U.S. Air Force. He worked at Perfect Circle in Hagerstown for 35 years. Following retirement, he worked for Culberson Ambulance Service, before moving to Florida.

Dave was a member of Nettle Creek Church of the Brethren, a former member of Hagerstown Optimist Club and American Legion Post 333. He was an avid walker and was easily recognized as he racked up the miles with his favorite walking stick.
