Earl Manuel Baker, 91, a long time resident of the Economy area, died Sunday, June 23, 2019 at the Brethren Retirement Community, Greenville Ohio, where he had recently resided.

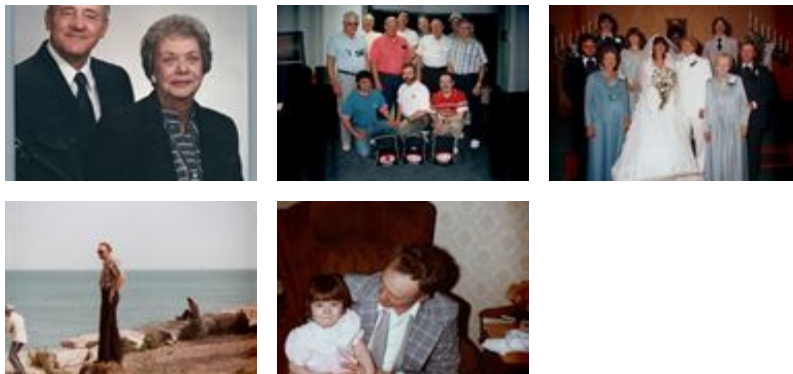
