Esther M. Waltz, 92, of Hagerstown, died Saturday, March 26, 2016, at Hickory Creek of New Castle.

She was born in New Castle on April 28, 1923 to John and Bessie (Tapscott) Frampton and lived most of her life in Hagerstown. Esther was a life member of New Castle Church of Christ. 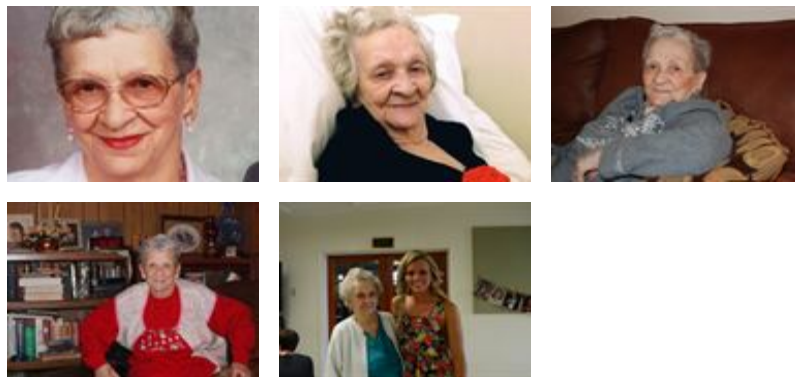

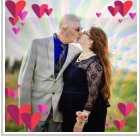
