Everett Hampton, Jr., 78, of Hagerstown, passed away peacefully, in his sleep, on the morning of Thursday, August 21, 2025, at Reid Health.

He was born in Hamilton, OH on January 16, 1947 to Everett, Sr. and Helen Hampton.

From a young age, he enjoyed playing baseball, basketball and many other sports. He also enjoyed attending school and learning.

He met his sweetheart, Susan Brack, while bowling and fell in love at first sight. Following graduation from high school he joined the Army and served his country in Vietnam. Upon his return, he attended Ball State University where he earned both BS and MA degrees in education.

After marrying Susan, they moved to Hagerstown, where they lived in the same house until Everett recently moved to the Leland Legacy in Richmond. They adopted two children, Lisa and Jonathan. Susan preceded him in death.

Everett was a teacher and principal in many school districts, including Whitewater, Northeastern, Hagerstown, Cambridge City and Richmond.

Throughout his career, Everett was involved with numerous clubs,

organizations and boards, including Hagerstown Library Board, Hagerstown Park Board, Hagerstown Optimist Club, Just Say No and the D.A.R.E. program.

He coached both of his children in soccer, baseball, basketball and softball. He was an active supporter of Special Olympics and any charity that aids children. He loved his community and helping those less fortunate.

Survivors include 2 children, Jonathan Hampton and Lisa Baker (Andy); 3 grandchildren, Tyler Garrett (Chelsea), Dylan Baker and Bailey Baker; 5 great grandchildren, Cyler, Carson, Aiden, Huntlee and Zane; 3 sisters, Patty Sparks (Clyde), Betty Taylor and Terri Hampton; numerous nieces and nephews.

Graveside services will be at 12:30 PM on Saturday, August 30, at West Lawn Cemetery. Pastor Rick Alvey will officiate. A celebration of Everett's life will follow from 1 to 4 PM at the 500 West Event Center, 500 W. Main St., Hagerstown.
