Frances Smith Workman, 86, of Hagerstown, died Friday, April 23, 2021, at Glen Oaks Health Campus, New Castle.

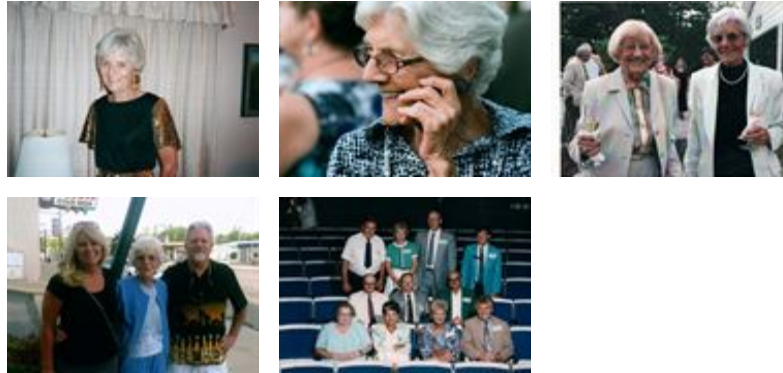
