Frederick C. Dilling, 86, of Hagerstown, died Thursday, March 14, 2019, at The Waters of New Castle, where he had recently resided.

Fred was born in Wayne County on June 21, 1932 to Ivan W. and Gladys (Chamberlain) Dilling and was a life long resident of the Hagerstown area.
