Geneva Davis died surrounded by her loving family on July 15, 2024. Geneva was born in Kingston, Tennessee to Edna Smith and Ralph Workman and raised in Sheffield, Pennsylvania and later moved to Greens Fork, Indiana during her childhood. She was a life long resident of Wayne County. She was a 1948 graduate of Greens Fork High School where she met her high school sweetheart, Howard Davis, whom she married and had five daughters. She was a farmer's wife and often worked in the fields in her early life along side her husband and bragged she was working on her tan. She was proud of being named Mother of the Year as a result of a nomination from her dear daughter, Polly.

She loved sewing, making lap quilts and was always willing to continue to mend her children's clothes right up until her death. She also loved to craft and was always making something for someone. Christmas was her jam!!! She loved her family and enjoyed spending time with them and completed a recent trip to Gatlinburg with her daughter, Laura and granddaughters, Sidney and Misti. She was a good friend

to many, a mother, a grandmother, a great grandmother, a great-great grandmother, and wife. She will be missed by many who have had the joy to see her smile and receive a hug.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Howard Davis, daughters: Mary Beth and Polly, her parents, and siblings: Don Workman and Stella Jennings.
