Ivan Lloyd "Buddy" Davidson, 68, of Economy, passed away on Wednesday, June 14, 2017, at Reid Health, Richmond.

He was born in New Castle on December 13, 1948 to Joe Denton and Olive Evelene (Kerney) Davidson. He lived most of his life in the New Castle area and had resided in Economy for the past 2 years.

He was a 1967 graduate of Hagerstown High School, served with the Army in Viet Nam 1968 to 1972 and also served with the Marine Corps. Buddy had been employed by several area factories. 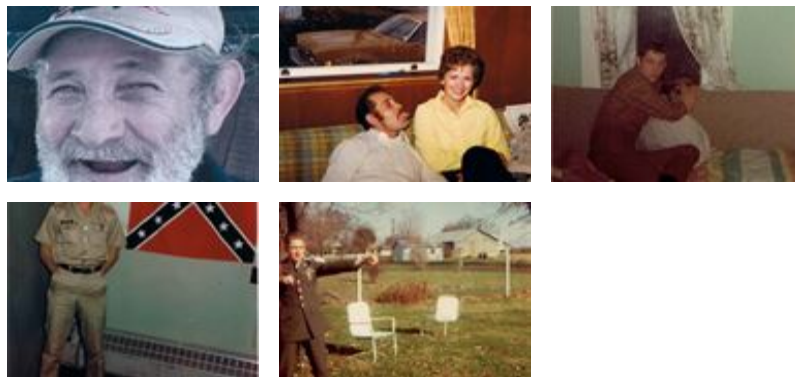
