



Jack L. Jarrett

July 8, 1933 - December 30, 2023

Jack Lee Jarrett, age 90, passed away peacefully on Saturday, December 30, 2023, at The Willows (Heritage House) in New Castle, where he had resided for the last several years. Jack was born on July 8, 1933, to Cleo and Christine (Huddle) Jarrett in Economy. He was a loving son, brother, husband, father, Poppi and friend to all who knew and loved him.

He graduated from Hagerstown High School in 1951, where he was active in basketball, baseball and as a class business manager who helped plan Class of 1951 Reunions over the years. Jack later attended Ball State University before joining the Air Force in 1953. While serving overseas, he met his future wife, Marjorie Tomlinson, in Metz, France, where she was serving in the Royal Canadian Air Force. Jack was playing basketball on the Canadian Air Force team, with his good friend Wes, as the “imports”. They scored most of the points, won the title and Jack won Marjorie’s heart.

They returned to Hagerstown in 1957 where Jack was employed at Dana Corporation/Perfect Circle for over 42 years, and where they raised their four children. Jack was active in coaching, and umpiring, Little League and high school baseball, along with basketball. He was recognized for his community contributions by being awarded the Lion’s Club 1976 Silver Anniversary Award. He was a lifelong bowler, participating in many leagues and tournaments. He was a diehard Cleveland Browns, Cincinnati Reds and Indiana University fan.

After retirement, he enjoyed rounds of golf and attending his grandchildren’s

sporting events. Jack was an active member of American Legion Post #333 and served as an officer. He attended, and was a member of, New Testament Church of Christ.

In addition to his parents, Jack was preceded in death by brothers Don Jarrett, Rod Jarrett; and, his two grandsons, Jason Chaney and Jordan Marlatt, whom he loved more than life.

Jack is survived by his loving wife of 67 years, Marjorie; brother Nick (Judy) Jarrett; sisters Beverly McClintock and Sherri Jarrett; sons Jay (Rose) Jarrett and Tod (Jeanine) Jarrett; daughters Lisa (Mac) Marlatt and Tracy (Rick) Jones; granddaughters Hannah (Kevin) Knight, Hailey Jones, Samera (Kenney) Holland; grandson Kasey and his daughters Fallon, McKenzie and Brynlie; great-grandchildren Kenslie Marlatt, Jackson Knight, Haylee and Maycee Holland, and a great-granddaughter on the way. He is also survived by many nieces and nephews.
