January 3, 1930 - March 17, 2017

Jack Kimble, 87, of Hagerstown, died Friday, March 17, 2017, at Henry Community Health, New Castle.

He was born in Anderson on January 3, 1930 to Wayne O. and Cluster (Reeves) Kimble. He had resided in Hagerstown since 1994, moving here from Daleville. 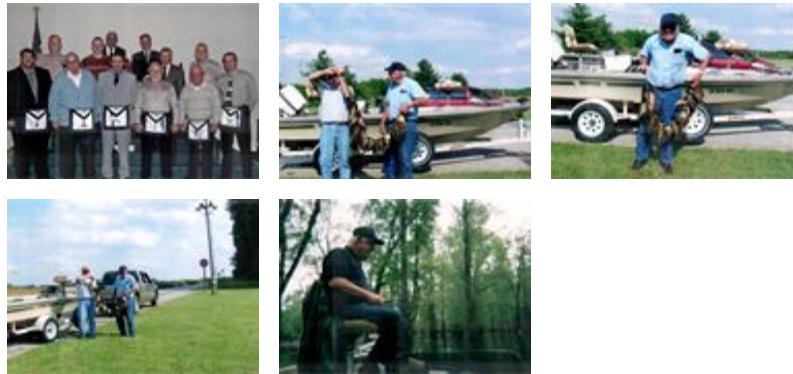
