John David Blankenship, 64, of Centerville, passed away at home on January 31, 2024.

John was born on February 7, 1959 in New Castle, Indiana to Olive Pauline Little and John Frank Blankenship. He attended The First Baptist Church in Hagerstown, where he was saved and baptized in 1972. He was a proud Hagerstown Tiger and a graduate of the Class of 1977. In school John wrestled and played football.

John was never afraid of work and one of his first jobs was passing newspapers on the north end of Hagerstown during the early morning hours.
