R. Joyce Farmer Dishner, 87, a long time Economy resident, died Tuesday, May 2, 2017, at Arbor Trace, where she has resided for the past several months.

She was born in Randolph County on October 27, 1929 to Edgar and Fanny (Cain) Farmer. She spent her early years in New Castle and spent most of her life in the Economy area.
