Kennetha Kay (Cash) Watts, 72, passed away Wednesday, January 22, 2025 at Grandview Hospital in Dayton, OH after an extended illness. She was born at Henry County Hospital in New Castle IN on June 1, 1952.

She attended Dalton School and Hagerstown High School. She spent her early years in Dalton. Kennetha lived in various places around Wayne County, Indiana as well as Lyons, New York, where she served her apprenticeship as a Tool and Die Maker at Eastman Kodak.
