The family of Larry Joseph Austin announces his passing on April 30, 2025 at the age of 73. Larry was born in New Castle, IN to Francis and June (Ross) Austin. He grew up in Fountain City, IN and graduated from Northeastern High School in 1969. He met his future wife, Brenda (Miller) Austin on a blind date in 1969 and told her he loved her three weeks later. The couple wed on November 28, 1970. Larry started working at a young age, helping his uncle on his farm and doing a local newspaper route. At the age of 18, he started his job at Meyer Manufacturing in Lynn, IN. At 21, he took a job at NATCO in Richmond, IN where he worked with his father and started his career as a machinist. Larry stayed in the machinist trade working at Delaware Machine & Tool in Muncie, IN, Boston Tool in Richmond, IN, Rector Engineering in New Castle, IN, Magna Machine & Tool in Messick, IN, and Metaldyne in New Castle, IN. Following Metaldyne's closure, Larry took a job at Really Cool Foods in Cambridge City, IN where he worked in the Kettle Room and Oven Room. Following Really Cool Foods' closure, Larry went back to machining and worked at H & H Design and Tool in Economy, IN until his passing. He always stayed busy outside of work and one of his favorite things to do was to mow his lawn and many others. He enjoyed working outside at his home and was always willing to lend a hand whenever needed. Larry's other past times included flying model airplanes, which was a love from his youth. He was a founding member of the Hagerstown model airplane club and made many friends when he was flying out at the Hagerstown Airport. Larry also enjoyed

traveling and spending time camping with his family, with some of the favorite destinations being Gettysburg, PA, Gatlinburg, TN and Davenport, FL where his in-laws had a winter home. He never met a stranger and his family had the saying "Dad has a new best friend" whenever he would strike up a conversation with someone. He also enjoyed spending time with his horses, and never met an animal he didn't like until squirrels got inside his camper. For most of his life, Larry attended, and was a member of, the White Branch Church near Hagerstown. Larry is survived by his wife of 54 years, Brenda (Miller) Austin, his daughter, Amy (Austin) Ryan, husband Patrick Ryan, his sons, Dale Austin and Darin Austin, his Brother Rex (Suzanne) Austin and his faithful dog, Molly. Larry was preceded in death by his sister, Patricia Austin, his father, Francis Austin, his mother June (Ross) Austin, and his father-in-law Charles Miller.
