Louanna Lamb Dishman, 77, of Hagerstown, passed away on Sunday, June 28, 2015 at Reid Hospital Hospice , as a result of complications from several long term illnesses.

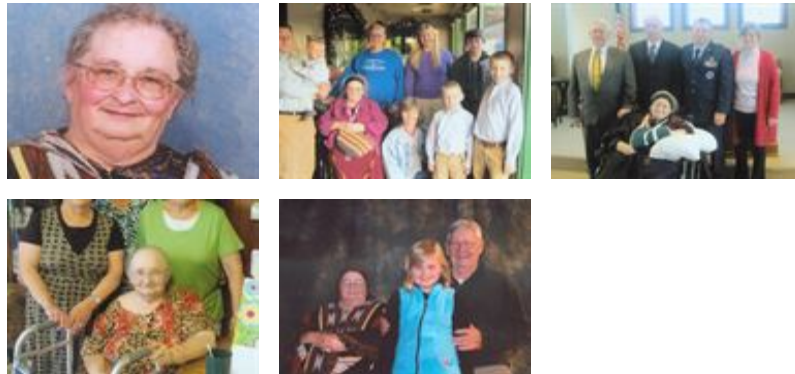
