Marfield W. Scruggs, age 87, of Greens Fork, died Saturday, November 28th, 2015 at his home. Born February 8th, 1928 in Greens Fork, Indiana to Guy James and Margaret Gause Scruggs; for the last sixty years he resided on the family farm in Greens Fork where he and his wife raised their family and farmed.

Marfield graduated from Economy High School where he played baseball. Upon graduation, he worked for Dougherty Orchards, Belden Wire and Cable, and Moto Mower. Marfield retired in 1987 from Economy Tile Company. On May 29th, 1948 he married Mildred Marshall and that union flourished for 66 years until her death in February of 2015.

Marfield had many interests; he enjoyed any sporting competition, especially those in which his sons and grandsons participated. He was a fisherman and for many years hosted the card playing shop in the former Economy Fire House.

Marfield is preceded in death by his wife Mildred, his parents, and his daughter Betty Sue Hurst.

Survivors include his two sons, Ronald (Lois Hoffman) of Economy; and David (Theresa), of Greens Fork. Twelve grandchildren, Rodney (Michelle) Scruggs, C.J. 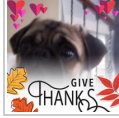
