March 5, 1921 - February 9, 2016

Nancy Alice (Harrison) Clark, 94, went to meet her Lord and Savior on Tuesday, February 9, 2016, at Arbor Trace, where she had resided since January 18.

She was born at Sand Gap, KY on March 5, 1921, to Andrew and Effie (Rose) Harrison, and was the youngest of 12 children.

She was a member of the Pentecostal Church in Sand Springs, KY before moving to Indiana, where she attended Tenth Street Pentecostal Church in Connersville. She resided in Greens Fork from 1942 until moving in with her daughter, Judy, in 2009.

Nancy was a homemaker until she started working in 1964. She worked as a Nursing Assistant at Jenkins Hall and retired from Golden Rule Nursing Home (Beverly Enterprise) in 1984.

She was a dedicated wife and loving mother. She participated in all of her children's activities during their school years. Close friends of her children called Nancy "Mom". For several years she prepared the green beans for the Greens Fork Servicemen Club monthly dinner meeting, until the club was dissolved. She was loved and deeply respected by all that knew her.

Nancy loved children, especially her three great-grandsons, Tre, Cody and DJ from Arkansas. Throughout the year she would laugh at their conversation on the phone and looked forward to July for their regular visit. They would walk and sit in the swing together. She would listen with pride to every spoken word. She was a loveable Gram to them.

Survivors include two children, Donald Clark of Greens Fork and Judith C. Scott of Hagerstown; five grandchildren, Michael Clark (Sandy) and Tammy Clark (Becky) of Greens Fork, Victor Clark (Amanda) of Casper, WY, Scott Clark (Robin) of Centerville and Shannon Brown (Dale) of Batesville, AR; eight great-grandsons; five great-granddaughters; two great-great-granddaughters; one great-great-grandson and several nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her school sweetheart and husband of 78 years, Everett "Shorty" Clark. Also by a son, Edward Clark, and her loving daughter-in-law, Phyllis Ann Clark.

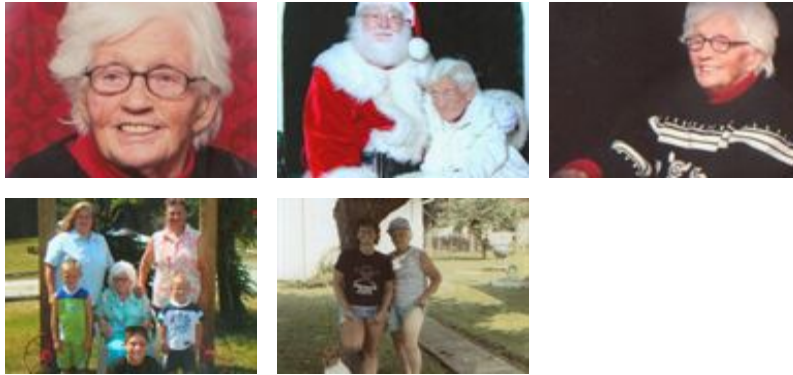
