May 13, 1950 - March 19, 2022

Norman Lewis “Hooter” Moore, 71, a long time Hagerstown and surrounding area resident, died Saturday, March 19, 2022, at Majestic Care of Connersville.

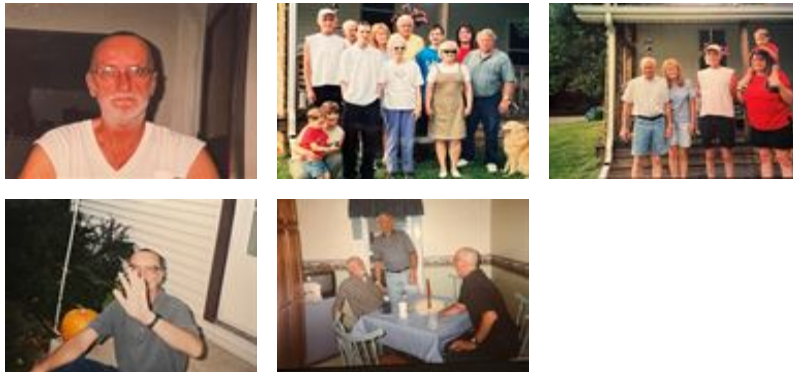
