



Ollia M. Hunnicutt

December 11, 1919 - September 15, 2015

Ollia Martin Hunnicutt , age 95, passed away in Cincinnati, Ohio, on Tuesday, September 15, 2015. Born December 11, 1919 in St. Bernard, Ohio, to James and Viola Moore Martin, her family later moved to Indiana where she started school. After graduating from Brookville High School she moved to Hagerstown, Indiana, where she worked for Dr. Miller for three years. Ollie married Albert Hunnicutt, farmer and hybrid seed corn grower, on March 20, 1940 and they lived on a farm near Greensfork, Indiana where they raised four children. They lived in Clearwater, Florida during seven of their children's school years, returning full time to Hagerstown in 1959.

In 1960 Ollie started working as a bookkeeper at City Hall in Hagerstown. In 1962 she became a bookkeeper -teller at the new branch of the West End Building and Loan retiring as branch manager in 1982.

Ollie loved to travel. She and Albert traveled to Europe, Mexico, Canada and all 50 United States. Fulfilling a lifetime dream Ollie planned and they took a trip around the world, to London, Delhi, Bangkok, Hong Kong, China, Japan and Hawaii. After retirement Ollie worked part time as a salesperson for a travel agency in Clearwater, Florida.

Other hobbies included oil painting, reading, playing piano, water exercise, bird watching, and activities with the children, grandchildren and great

grandchildren.

Ollie was a volunteer at Clearwater Community Hospital, Emergency Housing Clearwater, and the Dunedin Public Library.

Ollie was a member of Greens Fork United Methodist Church, Hagerstown First United Methodist Church, and Chapel By-The-Sea Clearwater Beach Community Church.

Surviving are children: Edward (companion Daphne) Hunnicutt, De Land, Florida; Carol (Jon) Beeson, Cincinnati; Susan Carr, Lafayette; and Randall (Dena) Hunnicutt, Economy. Grandchildren: Jonathan (Anna) Hunnicutt, Melanie (Brian) Swander, Brenda (Jeff) Pantalone Blunt, Bradley (Felicia) Beeson, James (Sunny) Carr, David Carr, Sarah (Cleo) Lyons, Allison Hunnicutt, Emily Hunnicutt and great grandchildren- Allison, Jack and Katie Hunnicutt, Benjamin and Sophia Pantalone, and Casey Blunt.

Ollie was preceded in death by her husband, Albert P. Hunnicutt, son-in-law Steve Carr, brother James Martin and sister Vietta Selcraig.

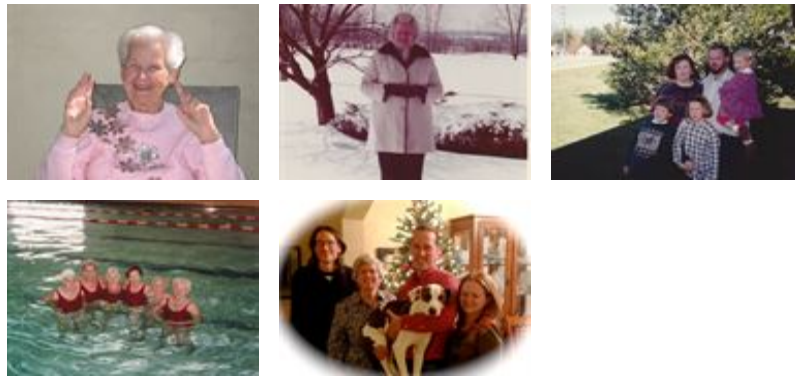
