



## Patricia J. Wittman

June 30, 1929 - January 17, 2017

Patricia J. Wittman, 87, a long time Hagerstown resident, died Tuesday, January 17, 2017, at IU Health Ball Memorial Hospital.

She was born in Connersville on June 30, 1929 to Fred and Alvena (Reidman) Reynolds. She lived most of her life in the Hagerstown area and had been a resident of Westminster Village for the past 1 1/2 years.

Pat was a member of St. Elizabeth Catholic Church. She was a retired teacher at Muncie Central and worked in the library at Hagerstown Schools.

Survivors include two children, David Wittman of New York and Deb Arnold (Jeff) of Muncie; three grandchildren, Jessica Durkovich (John), Jagen Arnold (Alison) and Alena Cooper (William); four great-grandchildren, Grant, Drew and Olivia Durkovich and Lillian Arnold; a sister, Beverly Burks of Redding, CA; a nephew, several cousins and many friends at Westminster.

Her husband, Paul Wittman, preceded her in death in 1998.

A funeral mass will be conducted at St. Elizabeth Catholic Church, Cambridge City, at 10:30 A.M. on Saturday, January 21. Fr. John Hall and Fr. Joseph Reidman will officiate. Burial will follow in Brick Cemetery. Visitation will be 5 to 7 P.M. on Friday at Culberson Funeral Home, Hagerstown.

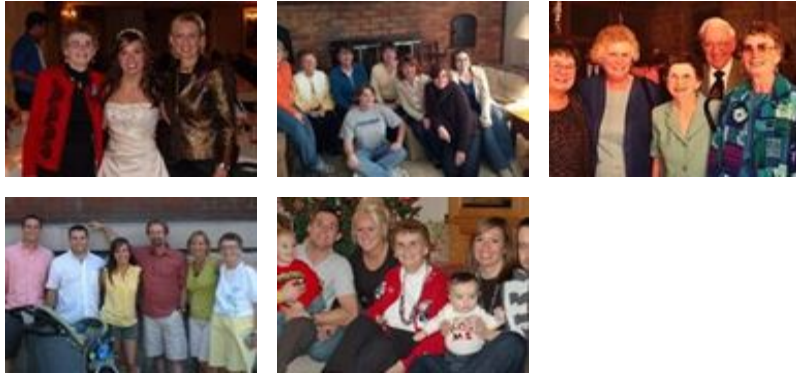

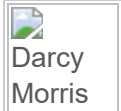
