Peggy Anne Michael, (nee Kitts), 87, of Economy and Largo, FL, lost her long and courageous battle with cancer on Monday, February 9, 2026, in St. Petersburg, FL.

Peggy was born in Burkes Garden, VA, and moved with her family to Indiana, at the age of 18 months. She attended school at Economy and Greens Fork, graduating from Greens Fork in 1956. Peggy was always extremely proud of her Native American heritage. Her great-grandmother was full-blooded Cherokee. Her daughter and family members have spent many years researching scrolls to find relatives.

Peggy fought this horrible disease for 18 years without complaint and always positive thinking. Having the support of the love of her life, husband Lloyd, and her family made her a fighter. Peggy was gracious, kind and humble, but was not afraid to chew out an umpire for a bad call. As a lifelong supporter of Hagerstown sports she rarely missed a game. She was also a staunch supporter of Bobby Knight, and IU Basketball, as well as KC Chief's football. Peggy's interest in sports and cheering on teams started with her children in elementary school and summer softball.

Peggy met Lloyd while working as a secretary at Hagerstown Elementary School. She also worked in the mail offices in Economy, Milton and Richmond.

She began working at Dana Corporation in 1974, retiring in 2001. She was an active member of BPW club, and was a recreational bowler with her Dana friends. Peggy and Lloyd loved to travel, attend sporting events and enjoying the company of friends and family.

Peggy is survived by her loving husband of 50 years, Lloyd; her two children, Greg Haynes, Hagerstown, and, McKenna Lynnzey, Largo, FL; and, her beloved grandson, Lance Corporal Rykr Walker, Kaneohe Bay, HI.

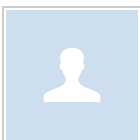
