Roy Manuel Johnson, 79, of Hagerstown, died Sunday, December 18, 2016, at Reid Hospital, following a brief illness.

He was born in Laurel County, KY on August 16, 1937 to Cecil and Billie (Creech) Johnson, and lived most of his life in the Hagerstown area. Roy was a graduate of Hagerstown High School. He served with the U.S. Army 1961 to 1963. He owned and operated Johnson's Service Station for many years. At the time of its recent closing, it was believed to be the oldest continuously owned business in Hagerstown. He was a former member of Hagerstown Volunteer Fire Department and a 50 year member of William O. Frazier Post 333, American Legion.

Survivors include four siblings, Della Rhea Reese (Wilbur), Georgia Ruth Lambert (Don), James D. Johnson (Cristi) and Paul Kennard Johnson (Anita); many nieces and nephews.

Visitation will be 11 AM to 1 PM on Tuesday, December 27, at Culberson Funeral Home. Services will follow at 1:00 PM. Pastor Paul Gearhardt will officiate. Burial will be in Brick Cemetery with military honors.

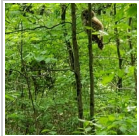

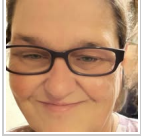
