Sarah Lois Pokorny, 82, of Hagerstown, died Monday, August 22, 2016, at Friends Fellowship Community, Richmond.

She was born in New Castle, Indiana on January 25, 1934 to William and Elizabeth (Clarke) Small.

She was a 1952 graduate of Hagerstown High School, graduated from Columbia Women's College in 1952, and graduated from Washington University in 1954.

For 25 years, Sarah assisted her husband in the operation of the family business, the Beaver Tree Service. She was a Cub Scout Leader, a Girl Scout Leader, an HHS Athletic Supporter, an accomplished golfer and a basketball aficionado. She served as a reader at First Church of Christ Scientists, Richmond.
