



Silas Eldon Denney

September 27, 1927 - June 27, 2017

Rev. Silas Eldon Denney, 89, of Milton, departed for his Heavenly Home on Tuesday, June 27, 2017 amid much shouting and singing.

He was born on September 27, 1927 in Wayne County, KY to Arnold and Nancy Jane (Raines) Denney. He served with the Army in Korea. He was called to the ministry at age 28, and built and pastored many churches. He moved to Wayne County, IN in 1970 and, shortly thereafter, became pastor of Faith United Baptist Church in Hagerstown, where he continued until his death. He was a member of Lodge #431, F&AM, Monticello KY. He was an avid hunter and enjoyed traveling.

Survivors include his wife of 68 years, Martha (Sloan) Denney; four children, Dewanna Brummett (David), Amanda Payne, Yvonne McKee (Mike) and Rhonda Lakes-Marcum (George); twelve grandchildren; a half-sister, Alice Roberts; many great-grandchildren, nieces, nephews and friends.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by an infant daughter, Rhonda K. Denney; a son, Dwight E. Denney; five brothers; two sisters and two sons-in-law, Alan Lakes and Gary Payne.

Services will be at 1:00 P.M. on Monday, July 3, at Faith United Baptist Church. Rev. John Meade will officiate. Burial will be in Milton West Side

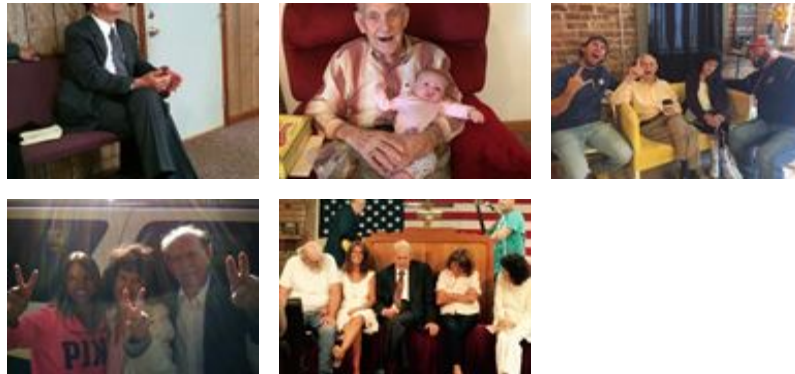
