Terry Moore Green, age 79, passed away peacefully at home on Thursday, August 19th, 2021. Terry was born August 21st, 1941, in Muncie, IN to the late Clifford A. Green and Myrtle C. (Southerland) Green. He graduated from Yorktown High School in 1959.

Terry worked for the Pepsi Co. for several years before opening his own restaurant, TeGre's in Losantville in 1979. Following that, Terry worked at Union School in the maintenance department. 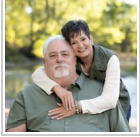
