



## Walter Eugene Beeson

May 17, 1931 - March 29, 2025

Walter Eugene (Gene) Beeson, age 93, of Hagerstown, passed away on March 29, 2025. Starting at the age of two, he grew up, married, had a family, and farmed and raised cattle on his family farm (which he loved dearly) for over 90 years until it was necessary to move closer to family due to his failing eyesight. He grew up Quaker and attended the Nettle Creek Friends Church. After marriage, he joined the Nettle Creek Church of the Brethren with his wife.

Gene was the son of Walter Augustus and Mildred M. (Souers) Beeson. He was born on May 17, 1931, in their Nobblett Rd home. Gene graduated from Hagerstown High School in 1949 and was the last surviving male class member.

He was also a proud United States Air Force and Air Force Reserve veteran. He served his country with honor and dedication for eight years on active duty and in the reserves, enlisting in 1951 until he was honorably discharged in 1959.

He married Eloise (Irvin) Beeson in November 1953 and celebrated 61 years of marriage with her passing in 2015. They had two children together, Bradley and Valerie.

Gene had many interests and hobbies, including his beloved Cubs and meteorology. He also planted, managed, and cared for his registered forest, from which he sold firewood to many loyal customers. Gene was an avid jigsaw puzzler and western novel reader. He never had a day on the farm when he didn't go outside to work and/or walk his property.

He is survived by his two children: son Brad (Lou Ann) Beeson of Brownsburg and daughter Valerie (Richard) Beeson Lyles of Atlanta, Georgia; five grandchildren; many great-grandchildren, numerous nephews, nieces, great-nephews, and great-nieces.
